

Tuition Assistance Award

Application Procedure

- Applications are available for pick-up at Landrum High School's Guidance Counselor's Office or on-line at www.landrumfire.com.
- Complete the application in its entirety.
- Attach a copy of your high school transcript to the application.
- Prepare a double-spaced essay of 200 words or more on the topic below.
- Submit all completed applications to the Landrum High School Guidance Counselor's Office (or to address below for homeschool students, private school students, and public school students not attending Landrum High School).

Essay Topic

• Describe your experience(s) with community service and how it has impacted you as a student and a citizen.

Qualifications/Eligibility

- Applicants must live within the Landrum Area Fire and Rescue District service area or attend Landrum High School.
- Applicants must have a 3.0 minimum GPA on a weighted 4.0 grading scale.
- Applicant MUST obtain a high school diploma.
- Each applicant must have a letter of recommendation from 2 high school instructors, as applicable.
- The recipient of the scholarship award MUST be enrolled and attend college for the fall semester of 2019.
- There is no discrimination as to race, color, religion, gender, or national origin.
- If selected, you will be required to complete 10 hours of volunteer service. This service program is specifically designed by the Fire Chief of the Landrum Area Fire and Rescue District (located at 200 N. Trade Ave. in Landrum) addressing current needs in the community.

Selection Process

- Applications must be completed and submitted by January 11, 2019 at 3:00 p.m.
- Applications will be reviewed by the Recruitment and Retention Coordinator board.
- Recipients will be notified on February 8, 2019.

Scholarship Value \$1000.

The review board has the option to offer up to two of these scholarships per year, dependent on the competitiveness of the applicants.
